CONSENT JUDGMENT¹

This matter comes before the Court pursuant to a _____² filed by JANE DOE. The parties have agreed to a Consent Judgment on the terms and conditions provided herein. Therefore, the Court, considering the law and evidence, and in light of the consent of the parties, rendered Judgment as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that JOHN DOE, SR, shall pay child support in the amount of _____³ AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$ _____⁴.00) per month to JANE DOE on the First (1st) and Fifteenth (15th) of each month. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the arrearage, by virtue of a retroactive accumulation⁷, totals the sum of _____ DOLLARS AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$ _____.00) to be paid at the rate of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$100.00) per month on the First (1st) and Fifteenth (15th) of each month until paid in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all prior provisions of all prior judgments not inconsistent with this remain in full force and effect.
